## SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

- DHIN CEO Dr. Jan Lee attended this meeting to enhance awareness and understanding of HIT initiatives which fall under DHIN's umbrella, several of which are not supported by SIM grant funds. A point of the conversation during this meeting and in future meetings is to determine the alignment of Clinical Committee initiatives with DHIN initiatives and to discuss integration points when applicable.

- DHIN and the Clinical Committee found the conversation to be helpful. Moving forward, DHIN will attend or be represented at DCHI Clinical, and other, Committee meetings to foster discussion around the integration of IT initiatives in Committee-level planning and operational work.
- Committee members received an update on the Department of Health and Social Services proposed approach to accelerating the adoption of payment reform and were asked how the Committee can help Delaware move from the what to the how with payment reform implementation.
- The Committee reviewed results from the Health Care Commission's Practice Transformation survey and noted the importance of identifying respondents. Committee members proposed edits to future survey language.
- ab+c is fine tuning their proposal with the HCC and hopes to finalize in the coming weeks. Some key points of their proposal include:
  - Enhancing awareness of practice transformation service
  - Enhancing information sharing among and across stakeholders
  - Identify the impact practice transformation support services have had on the patient experience and outcomes.
- ab+c is also developing a communications strategy to connect with current practices receiving transformation support. This strategy could include, but might not be limited to:
  - A learning collaborative with an interactive webinar format
  - Roundtable in each county with webinar functionality
  - Interviews with providers from small, medium, and large practices to get case studies for the website.
  - This information will be incorporated into a lessons learned paper at the conclusion of their work.
