SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

- Committee members were briefed on the SIM grant Year 2 Carryover funds request, with three Workforce and Education Committee initiatives included in the request:
 - Consortium

- Workforce capacity planning
 - Licensing/credentialing strategy
- Representatives from the Consortium and Curriculum shared status updates on their respective scopes of work and will report back with additional information for the Committee's consideration in May.
- Committee members received an update on the Community Health Worker initiative and reviewed the Subcommittee's next steps, which include, but are not limited to:
 - Discuss financing with health plans and Medicaid;
 - Review and discuss CHW training system infrastructure;
 - Begin identification of Subcommittee recommendations; and
 - Discuss potential legislative needs.
- The Committee reviewed findings from a peer state research exercise targeted towards implementing a single, statewide credentialing verification organization. The discussion revolved around the stakeholder engagement process that would need to be implemented in Delaware to begin a planning process. The Committee agreed that an Executive Summary needs to be developed to circulate to appropriate stakeholders to summarize work completed to date and proposed next steps. A draft version will be reviewed during the May meeting.

NEXT STEPS

- Develop an Executive Summary outlining progress to date and next steps regarding the implementation of the Committee's recommendation to streamline provider credentialing processes.
